Jacobs Family New Bedford High Schools Scholarship Fund

(For the study of science)

Dr. Irwin M. Jacobs, Chairman of the Board and former CEO of QUALCOMM, Inc., and his wife, Mrs. Joan Klein Jacobs, established the Jacobs Family New Bedford High Schools Scholarship Fund at the Community Foundation of Southeastern Massachusetts in August 2000. The Fund provides up to \$28,000 scholarships to graduating seniors of New Bedford High School and the New Bedford Global Learning Charter School who will major in engineering, mathematics, or science, including computer science, at an accredited college or university. Each scholarship is contingent upon maintaining a cumulative grade point average of B or better. Payments will be made directly to the institution of higher learning following the successful completion of each semester. The criterion for selection will be weighted 50% on academics and 50% on need. Dr. Irwin M. Jacobs was born in New Bedford and graduated from NBHS in June 1950. He went on to earn a Bachelor of Engineering degree from Cornell University and a master's and Sc.D. degrees in Electrical Engineering from MIT. From 1959 to 1966, Dr. Jacobs was an Assistant/Associate Professor of Electrical Engineering at MIT, and from 1966 to 1972 he was a Professor of Computer Science and Engineering at the University of California, San Diego (UCSD).

Dr. Jacobs co-founded LINKABIT Corp. in 1968, which merged with M/A-COM in August of 1980. In 1985 he co-founded the Fortune 500 Company QUALCOMM, Inc., and has served as chairman and CEO. Dr. Jacobs led QUALCOMM through a period of rapid growth to over 12,800 employees today, with international activities in digital wireless telephone and mobile satellite communications and Internet software. For eleven years in a row QUALCOMM has been selected by Fortune as one of "The 100 Best Companies to Work for in America."

Joan Klein Jacobs is a New York City native who has become a leader in the San Diego community since moving to La Jolla in 1966. She has played a vital role in her contributions to the San Diego arts community, and is currently chair of the San Diego Symphony Foundation, launched in 2003 to create an endowment fund that manages monies to ensure the future of the Symphony. She also serves on the Nominating Committee and is Chair of the Art Committee for the University of California-San Diego Foundation, and is Vice President of the Executive Committee for the Jewish Community Foundation of San Diego County.
